Thursday Day Tour

CASTLE TOUR

Explore the whole area of Prague Castle, the symbol of the Czech statehood and the largest castle complex in the world. Enter gothic St. Vitus Cathedral which was built over a 600-year period.

Pass the Old Royal Palace that was the real seat of Czech Princes and Kings. Explore a distinctive curiosity within the castle area, the Golden Lane, a cobbled stone alley of pastel-tinted dens carved into the ramparts.

Lesser Town is the pearl of the Baroque style. The most dominant building here is the monumental St. Nicholas Church.

The revered statue of Infant Jesus is to be found in the Church of Our Lady Victorious, Kampa Island.

The world-famous Charles Bridge also belongs to the highlights of this charming district on the west bank of the Vltava River.



Friday Day Tour

KUTNÁ HORA

The history of UNESCO listed town Kutna Hora revolves around the silver mines that made the city one of the richest and most important in medieval Bohemia.

You can find here a number of impressive buildings such as the church of St. James (Sv. Jakub) or cathedral of St. Barbara, one of the grandest cathedrals in Central Europe. Italian Court is one of the most valuable monuments of Kutná Hora.

The ossuary where human bones are used for decorations is also well worth a visit. Included: 2 course lunch at local restaurant Dacicky.
